His specialties are Art Direction, Production Design, Illustration, background artist, and visual development for many large studios (Disney, Sony, and more). We are proud to have Michael as our Fall Show Judge.

Entry Rules

- 1) All work must be ORIGINAL and completed within the last 3 yrs and NOT have won a prize in any Lakewood Artist Guild Show.
- 2) No wet or unframed paintings. All Artwork/paintings MUST have a wire hanger on the back.
- 3) Size limit: 40" X 48". Weight limit: 20 lbs.
- 4) Artwork must be clearly identified with title, name, and phone number on the back
- 5) There must be seven (7) entries in each category for the category to be judged. If there are less than 7 entries in one category, that category will be combined with another appropriate category.
- 6) No artist will receive more than one award for the same piece.
- 7) The Lakewood Artist Guild's Art director will resolve all questions regarding divisions and categories.
- 8) Artwork must be picked up at the conclusion of the Awards Presentation on Sunday, October 9, 2011, by 4:00 PM.
- 9) A 10% Commission will be due to LAG for the sale of any artwork

- Fine Art** **Class I:** Professionals, art teachers, and any artist who has won 3 First Place Awards in any show.
Class II: Beginning and Intermediate artists who have not won 3 or more First Place Awards anywhere..
Class III: Beginners: Oil/Acrylic only, less than 3 years experience.
